From the Attendance Office

GOOD ATTENDANCE IS A REQUIREMENT AT BELL!

This includes being on time at the start of the day and to every class!

You must come into school and sign your student out and in during the school day. Your signature IS the only excuse needed. Please only call the attendance line when your student misses FULL DAYS of school. The Bell attendance line is 303-982-4280, option 1. Please speak slowly when leaving your student's name and information.

ANY NOTE OR EMAIL WRITTEN TO THE OFFICE MUST HAVE STUDENTS' FIRST AND LAST NAME. NO NICK NAMES PLEASE!

If you know your student will have an appointment during the school day, send a note with your student with the time that you will pick them up and have them bring it to the main office before first period SAME DAY and exchange it for a pass. This process will help to ensure that your student is in the office waiting for you otherwise, make sure to allow plenty of time when you arrive for your student to be called to the office.

When your student is marked Tardy or Absent by a teacher after being in attendance during the school day, you will need to contact that teacher for an explanation or correction. You can find all teacher contact information in the "Bell Staff" tab.

If your student will be absent for more than 3 consecutive days, please ask for a Pre-Arranged Absence form. This will be filled out by parent, student and all of their teachers with homework assignments. Your student can get this form in the main office.

As best as you can, please make appointments for your student after class time. Bell students are finished with class at 2:10 every day, leaving plenty of time to schedule appointments after school. Be aware that students entering and leaving class during class time not only disrupts your students work, but also the teacher and the entire class. Thank you!
