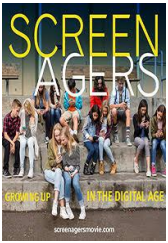


Friday Blast, March 8th

6:30 pm check-in & **6:45pm** meeting in the Golden High School Library.

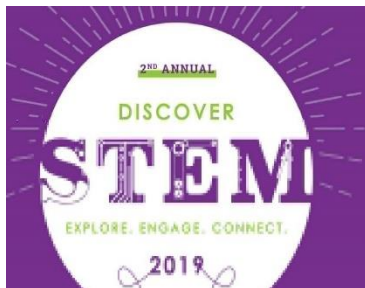
