McKinney-Vento Student Services

Are you...

In transition?

Living in a shelter or temporary housing?

Homeless?

If you are the parent/guardian of a school-age child and are without permanent housing, your child has the right to go to school per the McKinney-Vento Act of 1987.

Anyone who qualifies for McKinney-Vento AUTOMATICALLY receives free breakfast and lunch at school.

Anyone who qualifies for McKinney-Vento must be enrolled immediately and receive transportation to and from school.

If your residence is NOT fixed, regular, or adequate, you may qualify for McKinney-Vento:

A fixed residence is one that is stationary, permanent, and not subject to change.

A regular residence is one which is used on a predictable or routine basis.

An adequate residence is one that is sufficient for meeting both the physical and psychological needs typically met in home environments.

Eligibility--Who is covered?

Sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason (sometimes referred to as doubled-up)

Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, camping grounds due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations

Living in emergency or transitional shelters or abandoned in hospitals

Children awaiting foster care placement

Living in a public or private place not designed for humans to live

Living in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, bus or train stations, etc.

Migrant children living in housing that is not fixed regular or adequate
