- Grade:** 3rd – 8th
- Group size:** Minimum 8, Maximum 60 (40ish is ideal)
- Location:** At the park or at your school
- Program Length:** 1 hour
- Program Requirements:** This program is best in an area outdoors where the grass is very thin; dirt area with some small gravel size rocks is OK. The ground needs to camouflage dried beans, but not bury them. Minimum 60 foot square area.



Program Overview:

Through active learning students experience how aggressive exotic species take advantage of a wide range of resources in order to expand their range and compete in a non-native habitat. Presented as a relay race, each team represents an animal in our natural world and tries to survive as a species.
