

HOMECOMING CART DECORATING: INSTRUCTIONS & RULES

WHAT IS IT?

Instead of hallway decorating, this year each class will receive two mobile carts to turn into amazing mini parade floats. Classes will be given two hours during school on Tuesday to work on their carts and can continue to work on them during after school hours with permission from their assigned advisors.

At the end of the week, each class will choose two representatives to parade their class carts/floats through the elementary school for the elementary students to vote.

THE RULES:

Each class has an assigned theme--

Seniors:	Monster (think Monsters Inc.)
Juniors:	Ocean (think Finding Nemo)
Sophomores:	Jungle (think Up/ Jungle Book)
Freshmen:	Space (think Wall-E, Buzz Lightyear)

MATERIALS FROM THE SCHOOL YOU CAN USE:

- Stuff from your supplies bag
- Paint
- Construction paper
- Colored large rolled paper
- Crayons, colored pencils, etc.
- Staples, masking tape, and glue

MATERIALS YOU CAN BUY/BRING FROM HOME:

- Traditional craft supplies (paint, googly eyes, popsicle sticks, pipe cleaners, cloth material, cardboard, styrofoam, twine, yarn, burlap, etc.)
- Battery powered lights (twinkle lights)
- Repurposed materials (an old shoe, plastic bottles, soda cans, book pages, newspaper, etc.)

LOGISTICS:

- Carts can be connected or separate
- Carts must still be able to roll and move/fit through doorways and hallways
- There must be NO lasting damage or alterations made to the carts
- No glue or duct tape can be used to adhere anything to the carts
- Carts that do not adhere to all of the guidelines or tampering with another class's carts will result in the class's disqualification from homecoming activities
