

Welcome back, high school students!!

In this packet, you will find information about your class schedule for both in-person and distance learning. As you know, this year is going to look a lot different than past years. My goal is to make sure you have clear, up-to-date information so that you can be successful in your learning.

You are receiving two different schedules:

1. In-Person Learning Schedule:

This schedule is printed straight from Skyward and looks the same as past years. This is the schedule you will use when we are in “Low Risk” and can attend school in-person four days a week.

2. Distance Learning Schedule:

This schedule is the one you will follow when we are in “High Risk”--through at least September 18. During these times, most or all of your learning will take place online. The Distance Learning Schedule shows the times you are required to meet live (via Google Meets) with your teachers, and also the suggested times you spend during the day on each of your classes. We are giving you two suggested options for how you should divide your time:

- **Option A:** Work on all 7 classes each day of the week. This option is most like a normal school day.
- **Option B:** Work on some of your classes each day of the week. This option is more like a block schedule. If you choose this option, you will still need to “check in” on all of your classes’ Google Classroom pages for attendance records.

The live learning times for both options are the same--from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. on a set schedule. It’s up to you how to divide your learning time during the afternoon.

Remember, these are **suggested** work schedules. If you have a job that is taking up some of your time in the afternoon, move your work time to the evening/night/early morning as needed.

How the Distance Learning Schedule Works:

The WCHS staff has created a schedule of “Drop & Due Days”--set days by subject that we post and make work due in our classes. **All classes will post materials and have last week’s work due at 8:00 AM.** In other words, you’ll receive a week’s worth of online instruction and assignments, then you’ll have the rest of the week to complete those assignments before they are due and the next work is posted. See below:

Drop Schedule: days classes will post materials and collect student work:

In addition to the Drop Schedule above, each class will have weekly live meetings with students using Google Meets. It was important to the staff that students have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with materials and assignments before these live meetings so that they could ask questions and engage with the materials live. Because of this, we have set the live meeting schedule to be 1-2 days after students receive assignments in a given class. See the schedule on the following page:
