<p style="text-align: center;">Jamestown Programs</p> <p>2nd Grade Program- Powhatan Indian World- Students will handle and analyze clothing, bone tools, pottery and other reproduction artifacts as they learn how the Powhatan Indians related to the climate and their environment to secure food, clothing, and shelter. SOLs: 2.2, 2.4 3.3 3.8, 3.12 VS.1, VS.2, VS.3</p> <p>4th Grade Program- Life at Jamestown- Students will learn about the early struggles and economic ventures of the Jamestown colonists by handling reproduction objects of the period. SOLs: VS.1, VS.3, US1.4-5</p>

The TAG students will also visit the Paramount Theater and join Lewis and Clark for their 1,500 mile trek to the Pacific! This is a story of bravery that will inspire the sense of adventure and ignite interest in the history of our nation’s westward expansion.</p>
