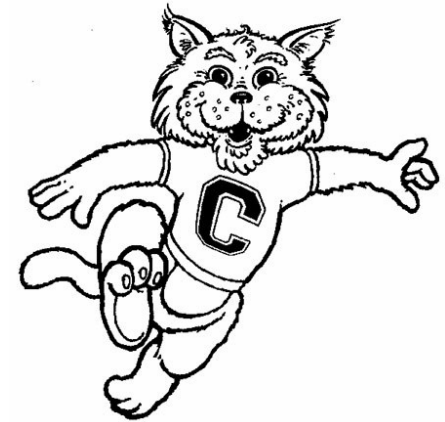

WHAT IS VTSS?

Virginia Tiered Systems of Supports is a process for building a safe and positive environment for all students to learn. This preventative framework is designed to optimize student success by using data to intentionally select and implement evidenced-based responsive services and supports.

EXPECTED BEHAVIORS

The behavior matrix is a detailed description of expected behaviors in multiple school settings. As a school, we are currently focused on "The Big 3" (Be SAFE, Be CONSIDERATE, Be RESPONSIBLE) in all settings - especially in the bathrooms.

DIRECT INSTRUCTION

Routines and language for appropriate behaviors are consistent throughout the school. Direct instruction of the expected behaviors will occur in various settings, allowing students to practice and receive feedback.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Students who consistently demonstrate these positive behaviors will be rewarded in multiple ways. Adults will provide verbal praise, students may earn a Good Office Referral, and may be eligible to win monthly prizes.
