Release Time

Grade level teachers are allocated up to the following time per class/section: Kindergarten-3 days, with 1/2 day scheduled by District for BK PLC, Kindergarten-8 days, 1st Grade-6 days, 2nd Grade-4 days, 3rd Grade-3 days, 4th Grade-2 days, 5th Grade-2 days.

Release Time Substitute Request Procedure:

1. Submit HPS Leave of Absence Request - accessible through howellschools.com website / Information for Staff

* Reason for Request: Select Assessment

*Request Explanation: Type specific assessment in this area (Ex: MLPP, DRA II, etc.)

*Substitute Account Number: See school secretary for account number

* Select specific date and indicate Full-Day, or identify AM/PM for Half-Day

2. Create absence in AESOP to request substitute - accessible through <https://www.aesoponline.com/login2.asp>

*Absence Reason: Select School Business

*Time: Indicate specific time and indicate Full Day or AM/PM Half Day

*Notes to Administrator: Type Assessment/specific assessment (Ex: Assessment - MLPP)
