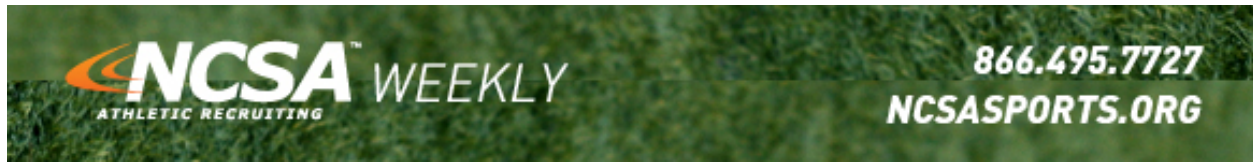


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## How To Be A Fortune 500 Parent For Your Athlete
