Check list:

- \_\_\_\_\_ All family members have been checked.
- \_\_\_\_\_ All clothing, sheets, towels and blankets have been washed in hot water (at least 130 degrees) and dried in a hot dryer for at least 20 minutes. (Remember coats, hats, earmuffs, scarves, etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Mattresses, sofas, carpets (loose rugs also), car, van, etc. and all other upholstered furniture have been vacuumed and preferably sprayed with louse killer. (This must be done every day for a minimum of seven days)
- \_\_\_\_\_ All clothing and other items which cannot be washed or dry-cleaned (including stuffed animals) have been stored in sealed plastic bags. (The recommended storage time is at least two months – put outside in garage, on porch, etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ All combs, brushes, ribbons, cloth barrettes, ponytail holders, etc. and other hair items have been washed using recommended insecticide.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Where pets are in the home, the veterinarian has been contacted and recommended procedures have been followed. (Please note, lice do not live on pets, but family pets may temporarily carry the lice. Pets should not be treated with lotions, shampoos or other insecticides.)

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As a condition of readmittance, one of the following is required:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ My child is returning to school nit-free; or
2. \_\_\_\_\_ My child is not nit-free, and therefore is returning to school with written physician approval (attached).
