**PRINCIPAL'S REPORT**

- a. High School elective information was specially shared with all gr9 students in block 3 on Feb 22. This PP is available on FFCA High School web site for easy reference by any student or family.
- b. Teachers have begun to complete our course recommendations. Students will participate in special advising conversations on March 15 and 23, block 4 both days to learn and review about course selection. Course recs will include AP prep and AP courses to allow data collection as part of the determination as to whether we will be able to offer these courses going forward. Individualized course rec forms will go home with students on March 23. Course selections will happen in late April.
- c. Development permit for new high school build was submitted Feb 16 and we should hear back in late March. A virtual sharing of high school plan with MCA is beginning to be planned. (Not sure when this will happen for FFCA community.)
