Upcoming Events

Spring sports awards night is Monday, June 6, 2022 @ 5:30 pm in the Loynd Auditorium. Team awards will be presented to spring sports athletes along with special year award winners. All athletes, their families, and coaches are invited to attend. Individual team awards will be distributed at team meetings following the event.

There will be **team information meetings** on Tuesday, June 7, 2022 @ 5 pm for any student interested in participating in a fall 2022 sport. We will meet outside (weather dependent) at Millen Stadium. Information to be shared will include: summer sessions, the upcoming fall season, online registration and eligibility requirements.

Fall sports registration is open May 30th - June 17th. It will then close and reopen from August 1st - 10th. The goal is to have all athletes approved by the first day of preseason practices. The athletic department will continue utilizing FamilyID, an online system. There will be no forms to print and the only paper that may be needed would be a current sports physical, as these must be updated upon entering KHS and every two years after that. Physicals should be turned in to the Athletics Director, Neal Weaver. See reverse side for directions.

Important - *online registration must be completed by a parent or guardian. There are three sections where students electronically sign as well, but the rest of the registration must be filled out and approved by the student's parent or guardian. Failure to properly register may delay a student's eligibility and ability to participate.*

Students can now complete their **IMPACT concussion baseline test** at home. This is required of all incoming ninth graders and must be renewed every two years. KHS Athletic Trainer Colby Locke will be reaching out to those students who need an up to date concussion baseline test.

Spring Season Highlights

Congratulations to the following spring sports teams on their end of season accomplishments:

1. The **girls tennis team** qualified for the postseason and traveled to Alvirne for a prelims playoff match. The Eagles put up a good effort but were defeated, 7-2. The entire starting lineup returns in 2023!
2. The **boys tennis team** finished 7th in Division II and traveled to Lebanon for a tough first round playoff match. The boys' season came to an end after a 7-2 loss. Well done guys!
3. The **track team** participated in the Division II state meet at Pelham on May 29th, with the girls finishing tied for 4th, just five points out of second place! Multiple Eagles are Division II state champions, including Aida Wheat (100m, 200m), Piper Lopashanski (400m) and the 4x800 relay team (Amy Burton, Molly Dellavalla, Grace Perley and Piper Lopashanski). All have qualified for the Meet of Champions!
4. The **baseball team's** final game of the season was with the Eagles hosting neighbor Fryeburg Academy. A young Eagles team returns a large amount of its core in 2023!
5. The **softball team** narrowly missed qualifying for the playoffs but their season ended on a positive note with a victory against Plymouth. Nice job this year ladies!
6. The **boys lacrosse team** finished their season strong, winning three of their final four games and just missing out on a playoff spot. Good season guys!
7. The **girls lacrosse team** again showed improvement this season and only missed the playoffs by a couple of places. This was only their second season of playing varsity games!

**KENNETT HIGH SCHOOL SPRING SPORTS REGISTRATION:
OPEN FROM MAY 30th - JUNE 17th!**



The athletics department will utilize FamilyID for our online registration system for the 2022 fall sports season. This is a true online system, there will be no papers to print and turn in. The only paper that may be needed would be a current, sports physical, as these must be updated upon entering KHS and every two years after that. Physicals should be turned in to the Athletics Director, Neal Weaver.

Important - online registration ***must be completed by a parent or guardian***. There are three sections where students are expected to electronically sign as well, but the majority of the registration must be filled out and approved by the student's parent or guardian. Failure to properly register may postpone a student's eligibility and ability to participate.

ONLINE ATHLETICS REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. From 5/30 - 6/17, visit the KHS athletics webpage (www.khsmwv.com/athletics). Registration for fall sports will close at midnight on June 17th for registrations to be reviewed and reopen 8/1 - 8/10.

2. Select the Documents and Forms link on the left side of the page. The Student Activities Code is located here. Please read the document, printing it for your records if necessary.

* The Sports Participation Health Record (aka Sports Physical Form) is also found under this link if you need a copy.

3. Return to the athletics webpage. Click on the Register Now Powered by Family ID button.

- For families who have already registered for a sports program previously on Family ID, you will simply click on the blue Login link at the top of the page and skip to step #6 below.

4. Once on the Family ID website, click the blue Create Account button at the top of the page. Fill in the information, agree to the terms of service, and click the green Create Account button.

5. Verify login information by accessing your email.

6. Once your account is created (you never have to create another one), either type in Kennett High School and click the green Find button, or click on the Kennett High School blue link. Select Kennett 2022 Fall Athletics Registration.

7. Click the green Register Now button and select the "section" sport that your child wants to play.

8. Complete the FamilyID registration with your child, save and continue, and confirm registration. When finished, you will see a message that your registration is complete. A registration confirmation email is sent to you and all information is routed to the Kennett athletics department - no forms to print out. If you wish to register another student, click the Register Another Person button.

9. The only additional things you may possibly owe would be an up-to-date sport's physical (which you can attach during the Family ID registration process) and a current ImPACT baseline concussion test.

NOTE: failure to register online may postpone a student's eligibility and ability to participate.
