

What is Child Find?

A Special Education service provided by the Camden City Public Schools to identify children ages three to 21 who live in Camden City and may be eligible for special education and related services.

Children ages birth to three years old can access a variety of services to meet their individual needs through the Early Intervention Program.

Cost?

Assessments, evaluations, and all special education services which are determined necessary by the IEP Team are provided **Free of charge.**

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Early Intervention Program

Birth through Three

New Jersey's Early Intervention Program provides services for infants and toddlers from birth to three years old who have developmental delays or disabilities and are in need of special support for their families.

Parent/guardians should call 888-653-4463 and a service coordinator will listen to your concerns and describe the types of services and other resources that may be available to your child and family.

Early Intervention services are provided to children:

- ◆ Within the family's routine.
- ◆ Within their natural environment (the home and community).
- ◆ In settings which children without disabilities participate.
- ◆ With active participation of the family.



Pre-School Disabled Program

Ages

Three through Five

Children between the ages of three to five, who are not enrolled in a Camden City Public Schools preschool program, and suspected of having a disability, may be referred directly by the parent/guardian to the Preschool Child Study Team by calling 856-966-4171.

Children enrolled in private day-care centers or Camden Public School pre-kindergarten classes who are suspected of having a disability and may be in need of special services may be referred by parent/guardian or day-care staff through the Early Childhood PIRT Team by calling 856-966-4171.

To the maximum extent appropriate, preschoolers with disabilities receive their education with non-disabled peers.



School Age

Ages

Five through 21

Children between the ages of five through 21 who are enrolled in a Camden City Public School, and are suspected of having a disability, and may be in need of special services, may be referred to the district's Child Study Team by their parent/guardian and/or school staff member through the school I & RS Team or guidance counselor.

Educational disabilities include (but are not limited to):

- ◆ Auditory Impaired
- ◆ Autism
- ◆ Cognitively Impaired
- ◆ Deaf/Blindness
- ◆ Communication Impaired
- ◆ Emotionally Disturbed
- ◆ Multiple Disabled
- ◆ Orthopedically Impaired
- ◆ Other Health Impairment
- ◆ Specific Learning Disability
- ◆ Traumatic Brain Injury
- ◆ Visually Impaired
- ◆ Eligible for Speech/Language Services
