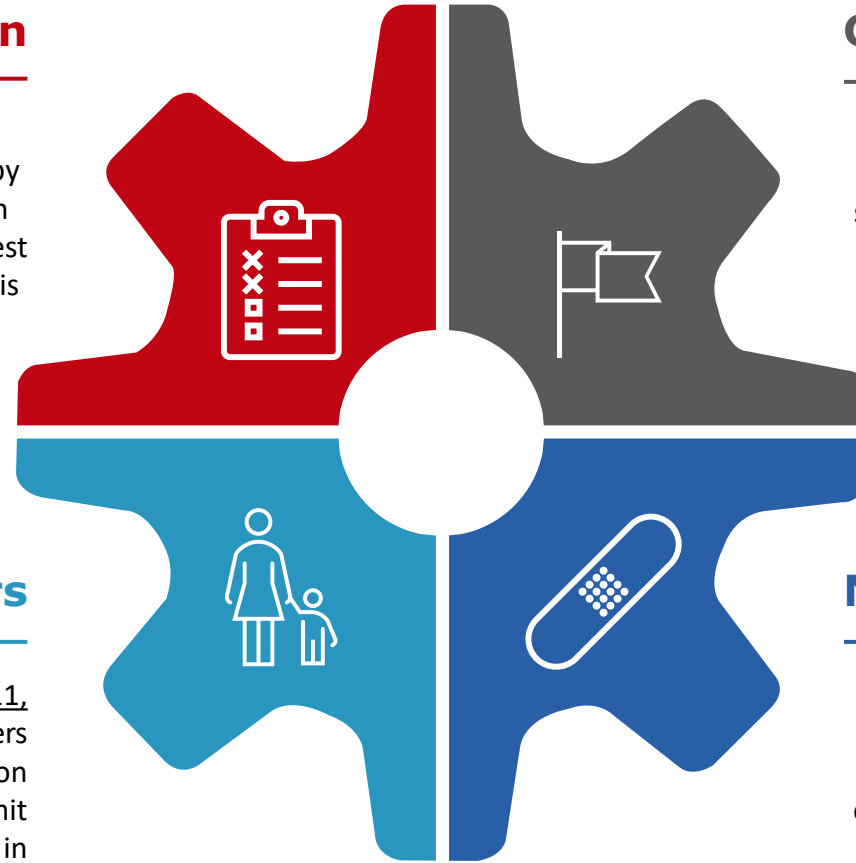
Covid Update

Testing Distribution

We are receiving 30,000 testing kits from CDPH tomorrow. We plan to distribute it to all school sites by early next week. The goal is to have the testing kits on hand for those students and staff that would like to test before school resumes. This is not a requirement but is strongly recommended.

Parent Volunteers

The State Public Health Officer Order of August 11, 2021 requires that all K-12 workers, including volunteers and contractors, provide proof of full vaccination (completion of the initial vaccination series) or submit to weekly COVID-19 testing. The requirements to sign in and complete fingerprinting will remain the same. All parent volunteers are allowed to volunteer inside the classroom and buildings.



Guidance

CDPH has eliminated the “within 6’ criteria for all staff close contacts. The new guidance says anyone who shares an indoor space with a communicable case for 15 minutes or more within 24 hours is in close contact and must test on day 3, 4, or 5 and is required to mask 10 days from exposure.

New Vaccine Approval

Indoor events we are returning to pre-pandemic practices, but principals should encourage families to wear masks when coming to an event. Parent orientations can be held inside classrooms and back-to-school nights should be in-person and can be held indoors.
