SPECIAL EDUCATION PARAPROFESSIONAL AIDE

Elementary School

7.5 hours daily per school year calendar, 37.5 hours per week.

Duties include some or all of the following:

- Tutoring, student supervision, behavior management, special education support, personal hygiene duties, assisting students with academic and social-emotional learning, and other duties as assigned.
- Applicant must be capable of lifting 50 pounds and must be able to be licensed by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction as a paraprofessional.

Starting pay is \$15.18 per hour, but is negotiable based on experience and credentials.

Benefits include 3 paid holidays, sick leave, retirement savings plans, long-term disability insurance, vision insurance, and single coverage medical insurance with the option to buy up to family coverage, \$900 employer contribution to Health Savings Account if enrolled in the district's medical insurance plan, \$2,000 employer match of contributions to 403(b) Retirement Savings Account.
