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WHAT: Softball field improvements dedication at Standley Lake High School

Thanks to a volunteer-led improvement project, Standley Lake High School's (SLHS) girls' softball team has new and improved softball field.

The *2013 Rightfield Line Improvement Project* was led by volunteers and funded by \$13,500 from the SLHS softball team and the Standley Lake Athletic Boosters, along with \$20,000 in donations of design and construction services and materials.

The much-needed field improvements, valued at over \$33,500, included construction of a retaining wall and associated grading and fencing to create a large enough area for the following improvements:

- New 55' long by 14' wide batting cage
- New soft-toss/tee work hitting area
- New bullpen that accommodates two pitchers at a time
- New fenced enclosure for player work-out area and storage and improved maintenance access
- Electrical outlets and lighting improvements

Primary project donors include Brannan Companies, Champion Fence, Keene Concrete Academy Sports Turf, Bestway Concrete, Boulder Land Consultants, Feola Trucking, Martin Marietta Materials, Sturgeon Electric, and Tsiouvaras Simmons Holderness Engineering.
