The Brave the Shave challenge began in 2000 when three men challenged each other to raise \$17,000 by shaving their head to support childhood cancer research. They far surpassed their goal, raising \$100,000. The success of that original challenge has inspired thousands more to brave the shave themselves, including Lakewood High School.

This is the third year Lakewood High School will Brave the Shave. The past two years, the school has raised over \$30,000. The event is spearheaded by junior Dakota Kisling, who has fought her own battle with cancer. She was diagnosed with cancer as an eighth-grader. This past summer, Dakota was cleared of treatment.

This year, the Lakewood High School community is proud to have one of St. Baldrick’s Ambassadors, Cheyenne Dyess, as their Honored Kid.
