

Cell Phone Policy:

Cell phones/electronic devices are allowed before, after school, and during the junior high lunch period.

Cell phones/electronic devices, and distractions to the learning environment such as phone calls and text messaging will not be tolerated. **Parents are encouraged to contact the office instead of calling their child.**

LOUISE ISD IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGED, LOST, OR STOLEN ITEMS. No administrative time will be spent searching for stolen, lost or damaged phones/electronic devices.

IF THE DEVICES ARE SEEN, HEARD, OR USED ON CAMPUS school personnel will collect the item and turn it in to the principal's office, with the exception of student lunch time at the High School Campus only.

If a student uses a telecommunications device without authorization during the school day, the device will be confiscated.

First Offense – Electronic device will be confiscated, sent to office, and a parent is responsible for picking up the item after school that day.

Second Offense – Electronic device will be confiscated, and a \$15 fee must be paid to the office before the item may be released. In addition, a parent is responsible for picking up the item after school. Any disciplinary action will be in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

Third Offense – Electronic device will be confiscated, locked in the office, and may be retrieved the last day of the school semester. Any disciplinary action will be in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.
