On the girls' side, all of the Girls' Varsity runners (Taylor Jack, Kiran Koch, Sara Kirimoto, Stella Abernethy, Kira Garrimone, and Ruby Cooper) achieved their season or lifetime best in the 5k. Taylor Jack placed 14th in the girls varsity race. For Girls' JV, Layla Wood, Gianna Bonasera, Gray Bazel, and Maddy Alegria Montano had lifetime personal bests. Congratulations Gators!</p> <p>On Thursday, October 13th the Boys' and Girls' Cross Country teams competed in the Jefferson County 4A/5A League Championships. Taylor Jack, Sara Kirimoto, and Kiran Koch received All-Conference Honors by placing 19th, 20th, and 22nd respectively in the Girls' Varsity Race.
