

Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) for School Year 2021-2022

General Information

Students must be certified as eligible for free or reduced-price meals through the National School Lunch Program during the current school year. Receiving meals at no cost this year does not automatically qualify your student for P-EBT. Contact your student's school or food service department if your household needs to confirm eligibility. Household applications must be submitted to the district/school foodservice department no later than May 6, 2022, to determine free or reduced-price meal eligibility for P-EBT benefits.
